SCHEDULE GS
General Service
Small Commercial Business / Shops
Rate 3

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all consumers for all uses subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Limited to loads requiring 50 KVA or less of installed transformer capacity.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single or three-phase, 60 hertz, at available voltages

MONTHLY RATE

Facilities Charge: \$25.00

Energy Charge

- First 10,000 KWH 13.30 cents per KWH
- Additional KWH 7.50 cents per KWH

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the higher of the following charges:

1. Facilities charge of \$25.00
2. As specified in the contract for service

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The amount calculated at the above rate is subject to increase or decrease under the provisions of the Cooperative's Power Cost Adjustment Clause.

SCHEDULE NM-D Net Metering Commercial-Demand Rate 26

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all consumers for all uses subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Limited to loads requiring over 50 KVA or transformer capacity.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single or three-phase, 60 hertz, at available voltages

MONTHLY RATE

Facilities Charge:	\$50.00
Demand Charge:	\$ 5.00 Per KW of billing demand
Energy Charge	9.03 cents per KWH

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand is based on the peak demand during the current month and the preceding 11 months and is higher of the following:

1. 100% of the current month demand
2. 90% of the previous summer month demand
3. 65% of a previous winter month demand

For the months of October through May:

1. 90% of the previous summer month demand
2. 65% of the current or previous winter month demand

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges may be adjusted for all consumers with 500 KW or more of billing demand to correct for average power factor lower than 90%. The demand shall be taken at 90% of the highest KVA demand recorded during that period.

Rate 26 (continued)

MINIMUM CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be higher of the following charges:

1. Facilities Charge plus any demand charges
2. Any amount as specified in the contract for service

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The amount calculated at the above rate is subject to increase or decrease under the provisions of the Cooperative's Power Cost Adjustment Clause.

EXCESS ENERGY GENERATED

Any excess energy generated and delivered to the Cooperative's distribution grid shall receive a credit of \$0.0470 per kWh.

SCHEDULE GS General Service – Prepaid Metering Rate 89

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all consumers for all uses subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Limited to loads requiring 50 KVA or less of installed transformer capacity.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single or three-phase, 60 hertz, at available voltages

MONTHLY RATE

Facilities Charge: \$1.00 per day

Energy Charge

- First 10,000 KWH 13.30 cents per KWH
- Additional KWH 7.50 cents per KWH

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum daily charge shall be the Facilities Charge.

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The amount calculated at the above rate is subject to increase or decrease under the provisions of the Cooperative's Power Cost Adjustment Clause.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Payment for service shall be made in advance ("Advance Purchases"). At such time as the value of the service consumed equals the value of Advanced Purchases, electric service is subject to immediate disconnection from the Cooperative by the prepaid metering system until additional purchases by Customer are made. Should the electric service be disconnected by the prepaid metering system due to Customer's electrical usage having consumed the entire value of the Advanced Purchases, the Customer Facilities Charge will continue to accumulate on Customer's account and will be deducted from the Customer's next additional purchase payment.

Disconnection for reasons of non-payment does not release Customer from their obligation to pay the daily Customer Facilities Charge. Under the Prepaid Metering Schedule, if the outstanding account remains disconnected for thirty (30) days, the Cooperative will consider the account closed.
